

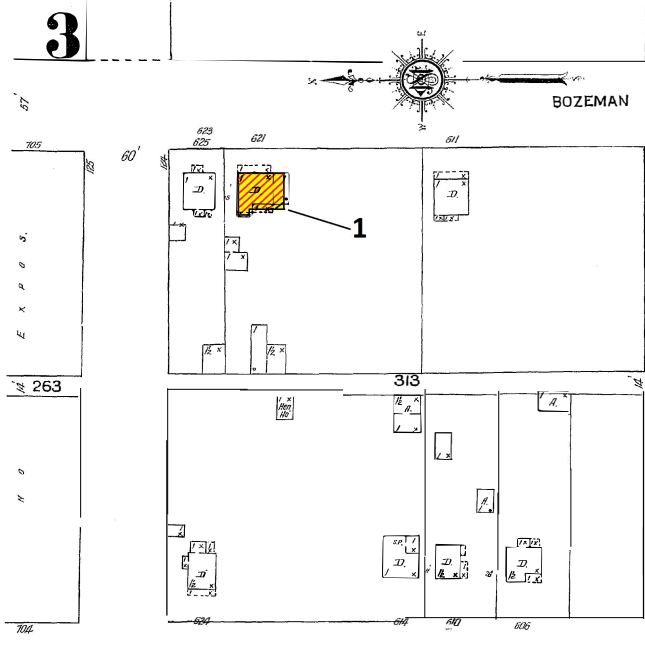
Bozeman, Montana Digital Sanborn Map Guide

Unique Identification Number	Address	Information	Sanborn Sheet Number
1	621 North Bozeman Ave	1930: Lulu and Walter Harrison, a couple in their 50s, owned their home here in 1930. Walter worked as a building engineer.	3
2	503 North Bozeman Ave	1930: Oswald and Ada Smith lived with their five children, Asa, Harold, Lucille, Nicholas, and Oswald Jr. Oswald Sr. worked as the janitor for a theater.	3
3	502 North Black Ave	1910: Eli (spelled Elie?) Rogers lived with his children Fred, Mabel, Edna, Henry, and two lodgers, laborer William Adgroff and his wife Stella. Eli worked as a porter for a barber shop.	3
4	611 North Black Ave	1910: William and Mary Bains, a middle aged couple, lived here in 1910. William worked as a brick layer.	3
5	304 North Montana Ave	1910: Charles and Eulalia Jackson owned their home. Charles worked as a cook, and Eulalia is listed as an artist in the 1910 census.	4
6	304 North Grand Ave	1930: Katherine and Benjamin Fish, a middle aged couple, owned their home north of Bozeman's downtown. Benjamin worked as a floorman for an auto garage.	7
7	316 North Bozeman Ave	1910: This was the home of Walter and Lulu Harrison before they moved to 621 North Bozeman Ave (see row one). In 1910, the Harrison's lived with their daughter Viola. Walter, also called J.W. worked as a foundry man.	9
8	108 North Bozeman Ave	1930: Frances and Henry Oliver rented this home in 1930. Henry is listed as a general laborer.	16
9	106 East Babcock	1930: George Gordon worked as a steward for the Elks Club located at 106 East Babcock. Apparently, he lived in an apartment at the club with other lodgers, all white.	21
10	401 South Miller Ave	1930: Frances Miller was 67 in 1930 when she worked for the Hartman Household here at 401 S. Miller. She lived with the family.	26
11	340 South Church Ave	1910: John and Julia Anderson owned their home. John was half American Indian and half African American. Julia's parents were both native Africans. The couple was in their late sixties and early seventies at the time of the 1910 census.	29
12	308 South Tracy Ave	1872: The home built here by Richard McDonald in 1872 was the first two story residence in Bozeman. His wife Mary, and their daughters, Mellissa, Mary, and Belle, all lived their entire lives in this home. When the youngest girl Melissa passed away at the age 92, she was likely the longest continuous resident of Bozeman and the Gallatin Valley, having been born in the house that still stands on South Tracy. (see McDonald House HPRF)	27
13	725 4 th Ave South	Fred and Emily Harris, a couple in their early thirties, lived with their infant son, Fred Jr. Both Fred and Emily were employed as cooks.	31

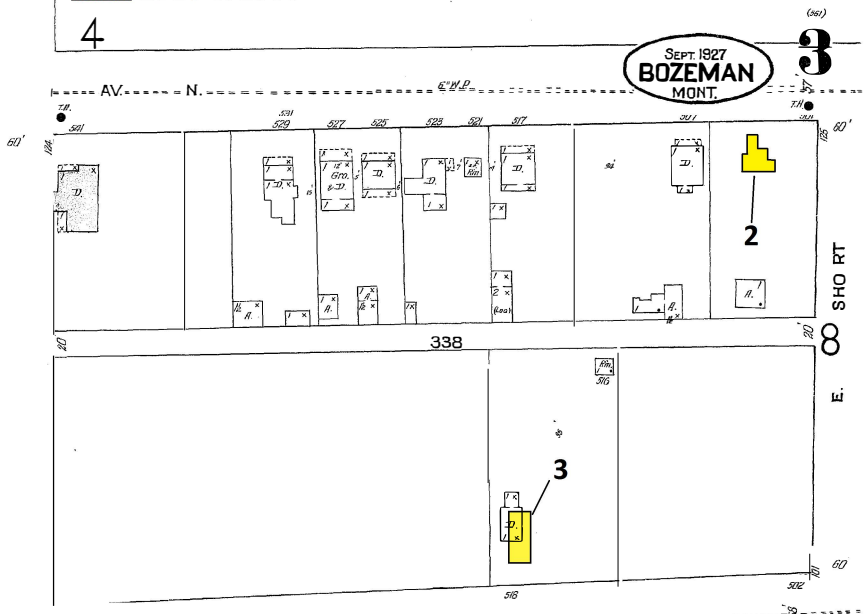
Bozeman, more than other Montana cities, changed the house number of addresses as the city continued to develop. For instance, the same physical structure in 1910 could be listed as 509 on that year's Sanborn, but changed to 519 in the 1927 Sanborn, and then 515 by 1930. For this reason, we have chosen to list the address number as it was given in the year of the census information. If the number given in Address column of the key does not match the number on the sheet, it likely changed from 1910 to 1927, the map used for Bozeman.
