19	302 5 th Ave South	1930: John and Marie Meadows, a middle aged couple. John worked as a porter for the railroad.	42
20	304 5 th Ave South	1930: Harry Johnson and Ruby Robinson, Ruby worked for a boarding house.	42
21	509 South 3 rd Street	1930: Addie O'Brian was a single 42 year old black woman who lived alone. She worked as a maid for a private family.	42
22	513 South 3 rd Street	1930: Charles and Sallie Taylor, a middle aged couple rented this house. Charles worked as a waiter for the railroad.	42
23	517 South 3 rd Street	1930: Emily Rodgers, a single 32 year old black woman rented this home and worked as a seamstress for a dressmaking shop.	42
24	305 6 th Ave South	1910, 1930: Lida Gaines, a 57 year old widow, owned her home in 1930.	42
25	717 South 3 rd Street	1930: Fredrick Rice and Hershell Moore, single black men in the 40s. Moore worked for a barbershop, and Rice worked for the railroad.	42

30	609 7 th Ave South	1930: J.E. Bowers and his Wife Florence lived here with a boarder named Elmer Young. J.E. worked as a chef for the railroad.	43
31	621 7 th Ave South	1910: C.H. Dailey and his wife Minola lived here with boarders Albert and Anna Jones.	43
32	614 7 th Ave South	1910: Edward and Virginia Bigbee lived with their 16 year old son Jesse Brooks.	43
33	616 7 th Ave South	1910: William McDonald, a musician for the theater likely lived here, unclear if he was only neighbors to the Bigbees, or if he lived with them at number 614.	43
34	605 8 th Ave South	1930: Marie Ellis, a 38 year old widow with three children, Mildred, Riadara, and Ted. Marie cooked for a private family.	43
35	611 8 th Ave South	1910: John A. A. Taylor and his second wife Quincy lived here in 1910. John worked as a wagon express man.	43
36	707 7 th Ave South	1930: Ben and Ethel Winburn were a very young married couple, Ben was 18, and Ethel was only 15 in 1930.	44
37	709 7 th Ave South	1930: Martin Smith lived here with his wife Emma, and children Madeline, Alma, Lucille, Martin, and Morris. Martin worked as a porter for the Hotel.	44
38	713 7 th Ave South	1910: Elizabeth Bigbee lived with her son John and lodgers, the Hagin family: Tennessee, Russell, and Wallace.	44
39	715 7 th Ave South	1910: George and Vinda Smith, and her sons Henry and John Connell lived here in 1910. In 1930: William and Susan Dotson owned the home. William worked for the railroad.	44
40	711 8 th Ave South	1910: This was the long-time home of William and Katie Knott, who built this house in 1892. Katie Knott would live here till her death in 1961. (See Knott HPRF)	44
41	914 5 th Ave South	1930: Reverend C. B. Clements and his wife Harriett lived here next to the Union Bethel AME Church where he was the Minister in 1930.	45
42	916 5 th Ave South	Union Bethel African Methodist Episcopal Church. See National Register Nomination in Places tab.	45
43	916 ½ 5 th Ave South	1930: A.L. Crockett lived behind the church alone, worked odd jobs.	45
44	1004 6 th Ave South	1910: Stephen Thomas Williams and his wife Mary lived here with their six children. 1930: Edna Hill lived here as a maid for a white family that moved in.	45
45	1008 6 th Ave South	1930: Charles and Elizabeth Joyner lived here with a lodger named Fred Spearman.	45
46	1108 5 th Ave South	1930: Christine Peterson and her husband Chris (likely white) lived with his daughter Elizabeth Webb, and granddaughter Jacqueline Webb. Chris worked as a chef for a café.	46
47	1118 5 th Ave South	1930: Middle aged couple H.C. Chase and his wife Kate lived here in 1930. Mr. Chase worked for a hotel.	46
48	1126 5 th Ave South	1930: Widow Sadie White lived with black male boarders Hugh Vaughn and Clarence Hudson.	46
49	1111 6 th Ave South	1910: John and Lida Robinson lived here with their two teenage children Wilfred and Mattie, 18 and 19 years old. John owned a team of horses or oxen and contracted his services.	46
50	1221 6 th Ave South	1930: This was the home of Rose Bairpugh, a central figure in African American community, she owned a beauty shop, and lived with her daughter, also named Rose.	46

60	708 8 th Ave South	1930: This was the home of John A. A. and Gertrude Taylor. Prominent members of the black community. See Taylor HPRF.	51
61	810 South 8 th Street	1930: James and Margarite Elliot lived here with their four sons. Edward, Clifford, James Jr., and Robert.	51
62	812 South 8 th Street	1930: William Jackson owned this home, and lived with lodgers George Young and Edward Rothchild. William cooked for the railroad.	51
63	815 ½ 9 th Ave South	1930: William and Pearl Brown lived in this very small house with their five sons, and four daughters. The nine Brown children ranged in age from 1 to 18.	51
64	907 8 th Ave South	1930: Jerry and Sally Reid lived here in 1930. Jerry was a janitor for the power company.	52
65	915 ½ 8 th Ave South	1930: Henry White lived here and worked as a trucker for the railroad.	52
66	1000 7 th Ave South	1930: Joe Beauregard lived here with an elderly woman named Angie Williams. Moses Williams had lived here in 1910.	52
67	1021 8 th Ave South	1910: Angie Williams lived here in 1910, with her adopted son Lewis. Angie was 61 in 1910 and worked as a laundress.	52
68	1024 8 th Ave South	1930: Robert and Ruth Minor lived here with Roberts brother Clinton. The Minor brothers worked for the railroad.	52
